## **Opening Hours & Visitor Information**

The Adur Art Trail runs for three weekends in June, from 8th to 23rd. Some venues are also open weekdays. Some serve drinks and snacks for a cash donation - or have cafes nearby. Many trail venues have disabled access, some have steps or stairs. Shoreham-by-Sea and Southwick are on frequent rail and bus routes; including Stagecoach 700 and Brighton & Hove Bus 2.


This map provides indicative locations to help plan your visit.


